RANCHITO AIRSTRIP – COROZAL DISTRICT

The Ranchito Airstrip in the Corozal District, still an uncontrolled aerodrome and not a port of entry, recently underwent rehabilitation works and is now open to the general public. The following are the particulars of the new Airstrip:

COORDINATES:	18° 22' 54" N 088° 24' 42" W
RUNWAY DIMENSIONS:	2200 ft x 30 ft (with runway centerline and runway edge markings).
RUNWAY ORIENTATION:	07 / 25
RUNWAY SURFACE	Concrete asphalt
PARKING AREA SURFACE / DIMENSIONS	Concrete asphalt / 200 ft. x 70 ft.
ELEVATION:	12 feet AMSL
TURNING PADS: (TWO)	60 x 60 x 110 ft. on southern sides of runway thresholds.
RUNWAY STRIPS:	70 ft. laterally on both sides of the runway. 130 ft. from the eastern threshold with a gully beyond this area. 80 ft from the western threshold and bordering fence.
VISUAL LANDING AID:	Windsock – mid runway
GROUND SERVICES:	Nil
REMARKS:	Extreme caution must be exercised due to trees to the western approach of the aerodrome, and perimeter fencing starting from 25 ft. north of the western threshold.

The licensee is the Government of Belize. This aerodrome is managed by the Belize Airports Authority. This aerodrome is for the use of single and twin engine aircraft whose Maximum Take-Off Weight (MTOW) does not exceed 12,500 lbs.
