PURPOSES OF FLIGHT:

ITINERARY:

1. All pertinent information for the control of the aircraft and its systems is required to be on board and available to the crew.
2. The flight should be conducted in accordance with the approved Aircraft Flight Manual and the aircraft should have the required signs and markings
3. The crew should have the required rating in force for the aircraft
4. The transportation of persons or cargo is prohibited, except those persons required for the flight
5. The flight should be conducted in accordance with the General Operating Flight Rules and/or in accordance with ICAO Annex 2
6. Flights over congested areas is prohibited
7. All flights should be conducted under VFR and during the day, unless otherwise authorized
8. These operational limitations will not be valid unless the aircraft has been inspected by an authorized Maintenance Facility or by a licensed Aircraft Maintenance Engineer. Moreover the following authorization Return to Service will require to be signed and a similar statement made in the aircraft logbook

- 13. This special flight permit is not valid for use in foreign airspace unless validated by the foreign Civil Aviation Authority within whose airspace the aircraft will be operated.**
