**AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION CIRCULAR**

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**TOWER HILL AIRSTRIP –ORANGE WALK DISTRICT**

The Tower Hill Airstrip in the Orange Walk District, still an uncontrolled aerodrome, recently underwent rehabilitation works and is now open to the general public. Some restrictions however, remain in place as other related work is yet to be completed. The following are the new particulars of this Airstrip:

<b>COORDINATES:</b>	18° 03' 00" N 088° 35' 00" W
<b>RUNWAY DIMENSIONS:</b>	1980 feet x 40 feet
<b>RUNWAY ORIENTATION:</b>	10/28
<b>RUNWAY/TAXIWAY SURFACE</b>	Compacted White Marl. Taxiway measures 100 feet long by 50 feet wide.
<b>APRON SURFACE</b>	Compacted White Marl. Area is to the southeast and measures 50 feet X 60 feet.
<b>ELEVATION:</b>	68 feet AMSL
<b>TURNING BAYS:</b>	None
<b>STOPWAY:</b>	100 feet. on each end.
<b>VISUAL LANDING AID:</b>	Windsock – south of Runway 29 Threshold
<b>GROUND SERVICES:</b>	Nil
<b>REMARKS:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Extreme caution must be exercised due to electric cables 1,040 feet east of aerodrome which is critical in the take-off climb area.</li> <li>➤ Also a tower antenna which is approximately 1.5 km to the northeast of the runway.</li> </ul>

The licensee is the Belize Airports Authority. This aerodrome is for the use of single and twin engine aeroplanes whose Maximum Take-Off Weight (MTOW) does not exceed 12,500 lbs. The aerodrome must only be used during **Daylight Hours** and when **Visual Meteorological Conditions** prevail.

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
