ULTRALIGHT OPERATIONS IN THE VICINITY OF THE PLACENCIA AIRSTRIP

All aircraft operators are hereby informed of the operation of an ultralight aircraft which will operate in the vicinity of the Placencia Airstrip. This ultralight (flying boat) will operate under the following conditions:

- 1. have two-way radio communication equipment on frequency 122.8 MHz;
- 2. except for departures or arrivals from point of origin (1.7 nm south of the Placencia Airstrip), operations will be conducted outside of a 3 nm radius from the Placencia Airstrip;
- 3. avoid overflights of all populated areas;
- 4. operate not above 800 feet Above Ground Level;
- 5. use callsign "FLYING BOAT"
- 6. operations are to be conducted between sunrise and sunset and in Visual Meteorological Conditions.

The Air Traffic Control Tower at the Philip S. W. Goldson International Airport is to be informed of any irregularity noted which may pose a hazard to air navigation. The telephone number is 225-2153.
