BELMOPAN AIRSTRIP – CAYO DISTRICT

The Hector Silva Airstrip in Belmopan, still an uncontrolled aerodrome and not a port of entry, recently underwent rehabilitation works and is now open to the general public. The following are the new particulars of the new Airstrip:

COORDINATES:	17° 16' 15" N 088° 46' 52" W
RUNWAY DIMENSIONS:	3250 ft x 60 ft
RUNWAY ORIENTATION:	11/29
RUNWAY/TAXIWAY SURFACE	Asphalt
PARKING AREA SURFACE	Asphalt
ELEVATION:	185 feet AMSL
TURNING BAYS:	166 ft. on West end and 140 ft. on East end
STOPWAYS:	150 ft. on each end.
VISUAL LANDING AID:	Windsock – south of Runway 11 Threshold
GROUND SERVICES:	Nil
REMARKS:	Extreme caution must be exercised due to trees surrounding the aerodrome, especially those found 300 ft. East of runway on approach for Runway 29.

The licensee is the Government of Belize. This aerodrome is for the use of single and twin engine aeroplanes whose Maximum Take-Off Weight (MTOW) does not exceed 12,500 lbs.
