ENROUTE OBSTACLE (TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER)

Please be informed that a telecommunications tower has been erected within the Control Zone – southeast of the Philip S. W. Goldson International Airport (PGIA) and just southwest of the Belize City Municipal Airport.

Particulars of this self -supporting obstacle are:

- (a) **Name:** INTELCO Tower #2
- (b) **Latitude and Longitude:** 17° 30' 27' N 088° 12' 57' W
(GPS Readings)
- (c) **Geographical Position:** At BELAMA Site – Praxair's Compound,
2½ Miles Northern Highway
- (d) **Height:** 260 feet (80 metres) AGL
- (e) **Markings:** Painted throughout its height with
alternating orange and white bands. (aviation colours)
- (f) **Lightings:** Flashing white strobe lights - H24; and
red obstructions lights.

Pilots are advised to be alert when operating in abovementioned area; especially when joining right hand traffic patterns for Runway 12 and when departing southbound from Runway 30 - Belize City Municipal Airport.
