HIDDEN VALLEY AIRSTRIP – CAYO DISTRICT

The HIDDEN VALLEY AIRSTRIP in the Mountain Pine Ridge Area, Cayo District, is an uncontrolled aerodrome and newly opened. The following are the particulars of this Airstrip:

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COORDINATES:	17° 03.791' N 088° 51.743' W
RUNWAY DIMENSIONS:	2400 feet x 60 feet
RUNWAY DESIGNATION NUMBERS:	12/30
RUNWAY/TAXIWAY SURFACE	Compacted sand and gravel. No taxiway. Runway has a downward slope at 660 feet from the southeastern threshold.
RUNWAY STRIPS	Clearings of 60 feet at northern and southern sections of the runway. 200 feet from runway end extremities. Clearway of approximately 2,000 feet. Strips surrounded by pine trees.
APRON SURFACE	Compacted sand and gravel. Length - 400 feet and Width - 60 feet and is immediately adjacent the runway.
ELEVATION:	1500 feet AMSL
TURNING AREAS:	50 ft. x 60 ft. turning areas are at both runway end extremities.
STOPWAY:	50 feet. on each end.
VISUAL LANDING AID:	Windsock – north and abeam mid Runway
GROUND SERVICES:	Nil

	Prior to landings an assessment of runway conditions must be made.

The licensee is Hidden Valley Enterprises Ltd. c/o Mr. Trevor Roe. This aerodrome is for the use of single and twin engine aeroplanes and whose Maximum Take-Off Weight (MTOW) does not exceed 12,500 lbs. The aerodrome must be used ONLY during **Daylight Hours** and when **Visual Meteorological Conditions prevail.**
