Please be informed that our new NDB that was installed in June, 2004 at the Philip S. W. Goldson International Airport (PGIA) is commissioned. On the 27th August, 2004, the verification checks were completed and the results were satisfactory. Aircraft operators can now tune in to the NDB as a secondary Radio Aid in case the DVOR becomes U/S.
